Coveside Bed and Breakfast is located on a rocky cove near the hamlet of Five Islands, on Georgetown Island in midcoast Maine. It sits on five secluded acres, across



the cove from a working lobster wharf. Locals regard Georgetown as an undiscovered jewel, with fishing villages, tiny resort enclaves, and Reid State Park – one

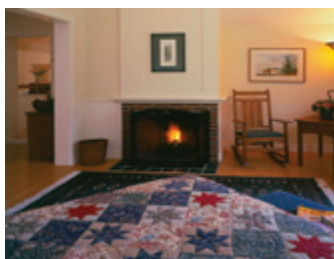


of Maine's most beautiful seaside preserves. Yet Freeport, Boothbay Harbor, Camden, and the bustle of Route 1 are within easy reach.

The seven guest rooms are spread between the main house and an adjacent cottage. All rooms have private baths (one with a spa tub), and all have a full view down the lawn to

Gott's Cove and, beyond, to Sheepscot Bay. Several have fireplaces and private porches overlooking the water. Bedrooms and public areas are tastefully furnished in

a style reminiscent of the seaside summer cottages of the early years of the Twentieth Century. Rooms begin at \$110 per night. Rates include a memorable breakfast,



served on our waterside terrace in good weather, and use of our bicycles and canoe.
